TODAY!

The Kingdom generated **USD\$46.21** Billion in new investment from overseas, at a time when the world was fighting the coronavirus. Out of this, **\$152** Million was invested in Saudi SMEs sector

As part of the 2030 vision, Saudi Arabia believes in the role of the small and medium businesses towards the economic growth and hence is willing to support these organizations by opening up investment opportunities to them by establishing an SME Authority, which works on providing business-friendly regulations, easier access to funding, international partnerships and a greater share of national procurement and government bids.

The Ministry of Investment of Saudi Arabia (MISA) issued **466** foreign investor licenses in the fourth quarter of 2020 (**52%** increase from previous quarter and **60%** increase over the same period in 2019.

Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) flowed up to **20%** over the year.

MISA's COVID-19 Response Center (MCRC) was cited as an example of global best practice to mitigate the financial effects of the pandemic on the private sector.


