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
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About the **Competition**

The Start Smart Competition, organized & supported by Community Jameel Saudi and Bab Rizq Jameel, is an annual competition designed to empower entrepreneurs and foster an ecosystem of innovation and entrepreneurship from Saudi Arabia.

The competition pits entrepreneurs in Four different tracks: Ideas, Startups, Social Entrepreneurship, and Environment Track. A total of 12 winners across the different tracks will receive cash prizes and will benefit from a range of other activities including top-tier training, mentorship, coaching, media exposure and great networking opportunities through a journey full of excitement and challenges.
